

Frequently Asked Questions

Is it necessary to be a member to use City Club of Fort Worth?

You do not need to be a member to host an event at the City Club. But you do have to be a member in order to dine in the restaurants, work out in the Fitness Centers or attend the social events.

Is it necessary to have an appointment to tour City Club?

It is not mandatory but an appointment is preferred in order to have ample time to meet with the Membership Director.

Is there a charge for parking?

Parking is available in Garage I located at the 200 block of Commerce and Garage II located at Calhoun Street between 3rd and 4th streets. As a privilege of membership, City Club provides complimentary parking for up to 3 hours in Sundance Garages I and II, which are attached via skybridge to the Bank of America Tower. There is no charge for parking after 6:00PM or on Saturdays.

Does the club have Internet capabilities?

The Club has wireless internet capabilities as well as DSL.

Is there a Dress Code?

Guests of City Club are expected to dress appropriately for the occasion. Shorts, t-shirts, jeans, flip-flops and sneakers are not acceptable. Please see the complete Dress Code under Rules & Regulations.
